We are passionate disciples of Christ and are committed to gathering together often as we grow in our love and knowledge of our Savior. We get together in many ways.

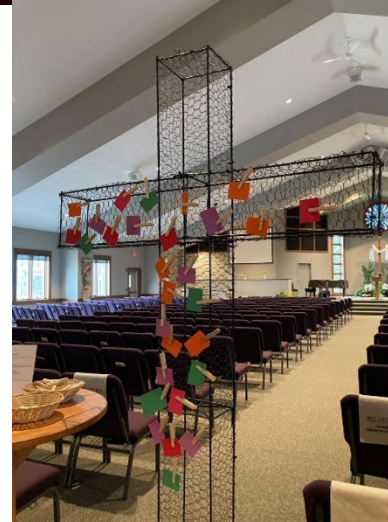

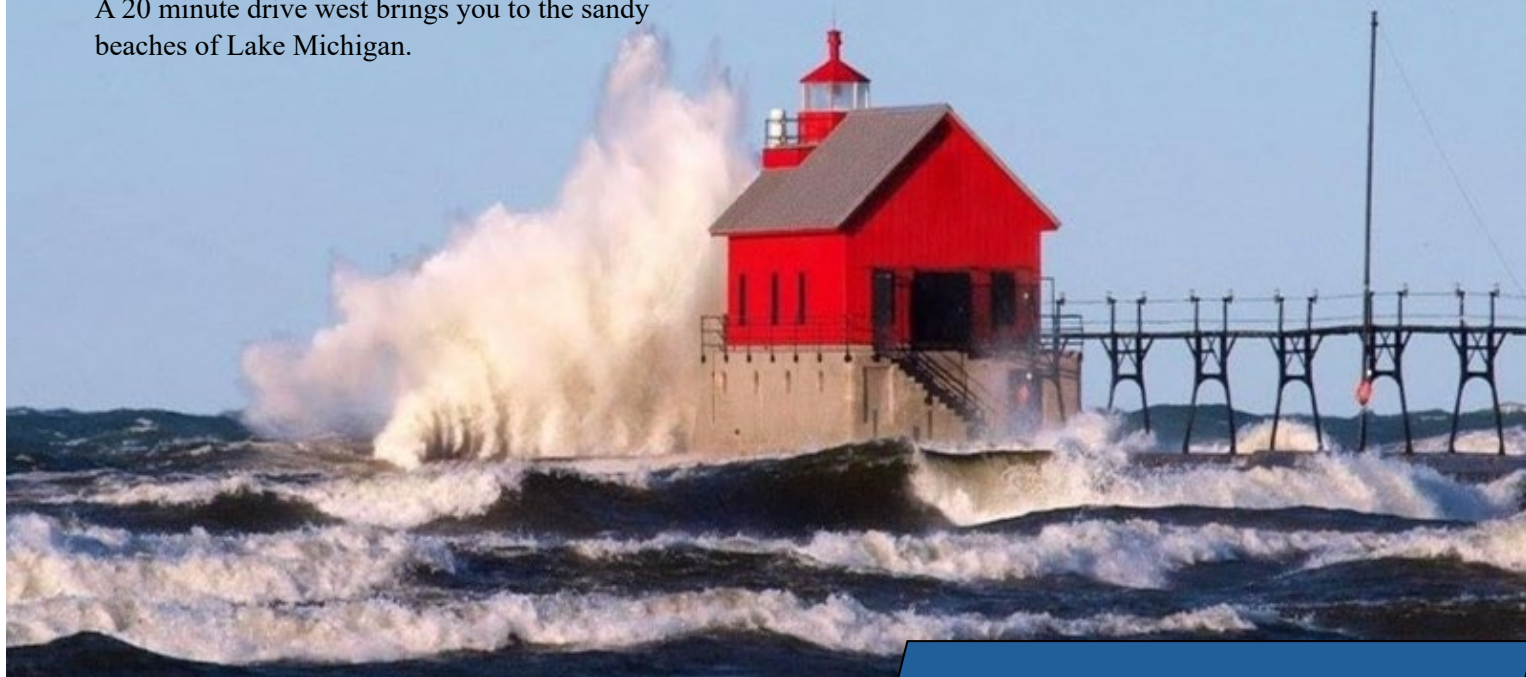
Living Together

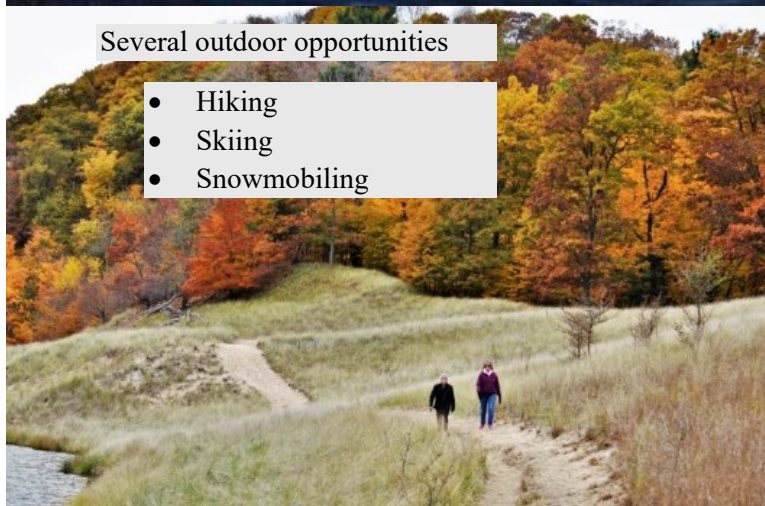
Enjoy Our Surroundings
