Demographics: The fourth section contains demographic information for your congregation compared with other participating congregations.

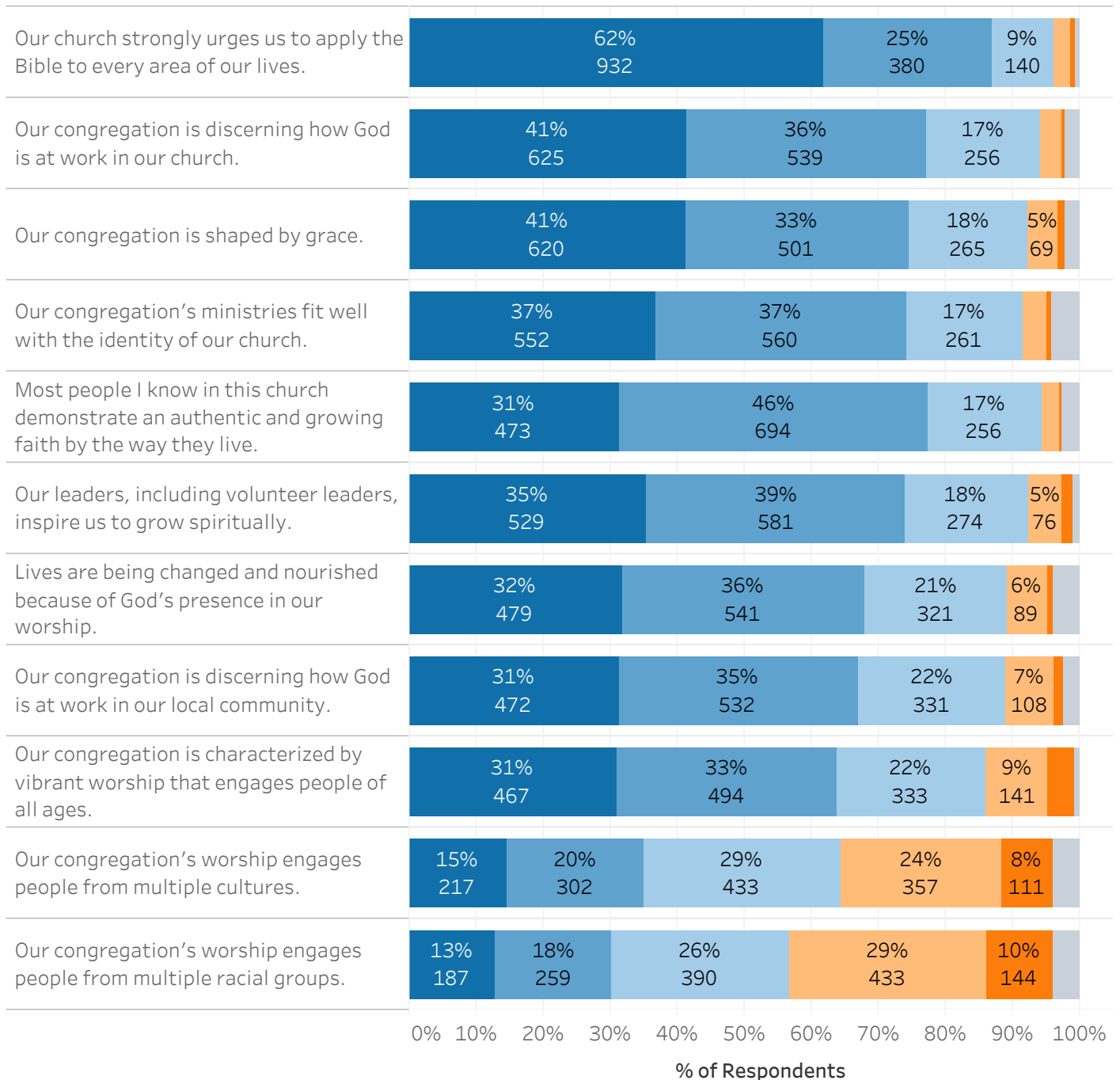

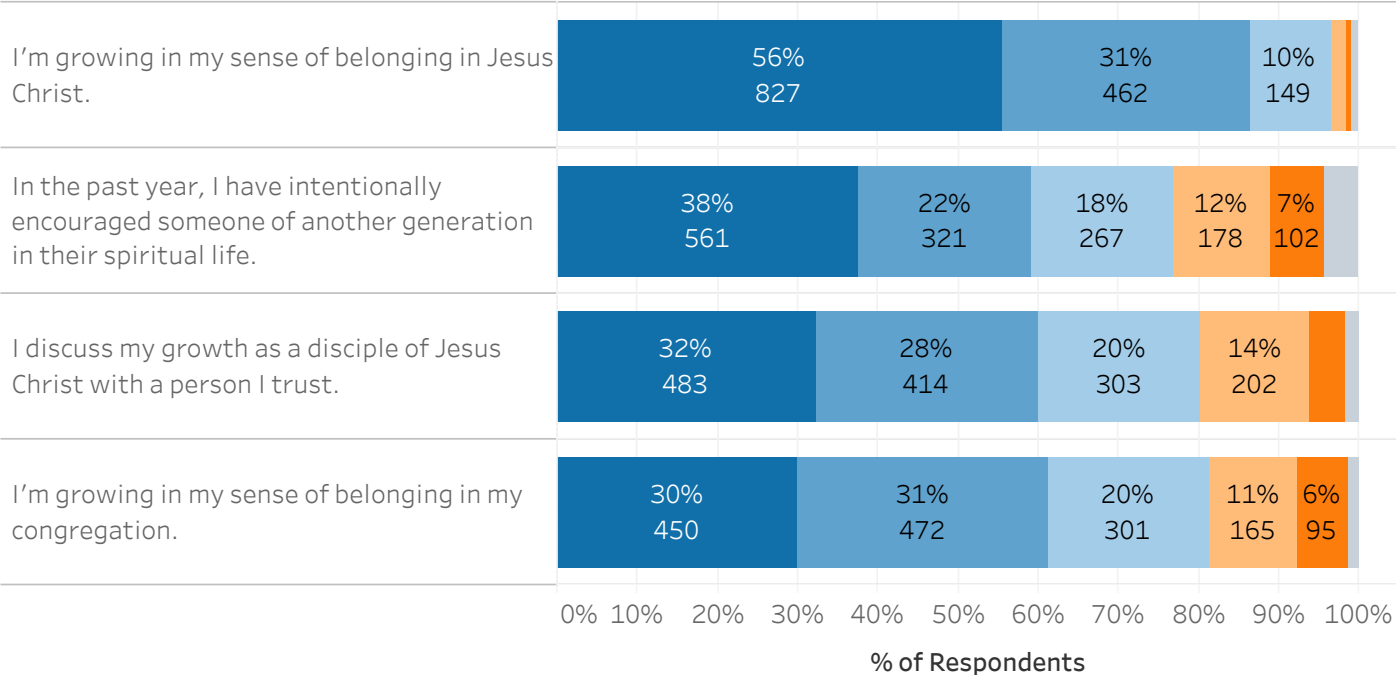

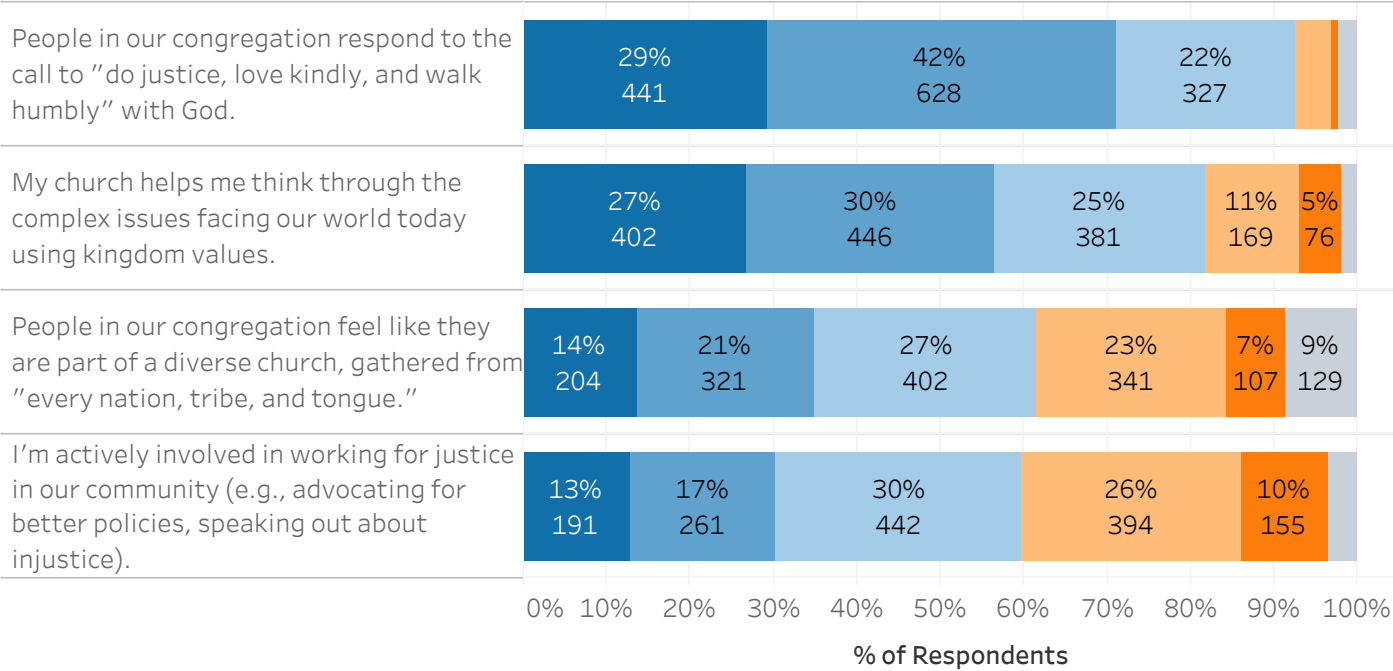

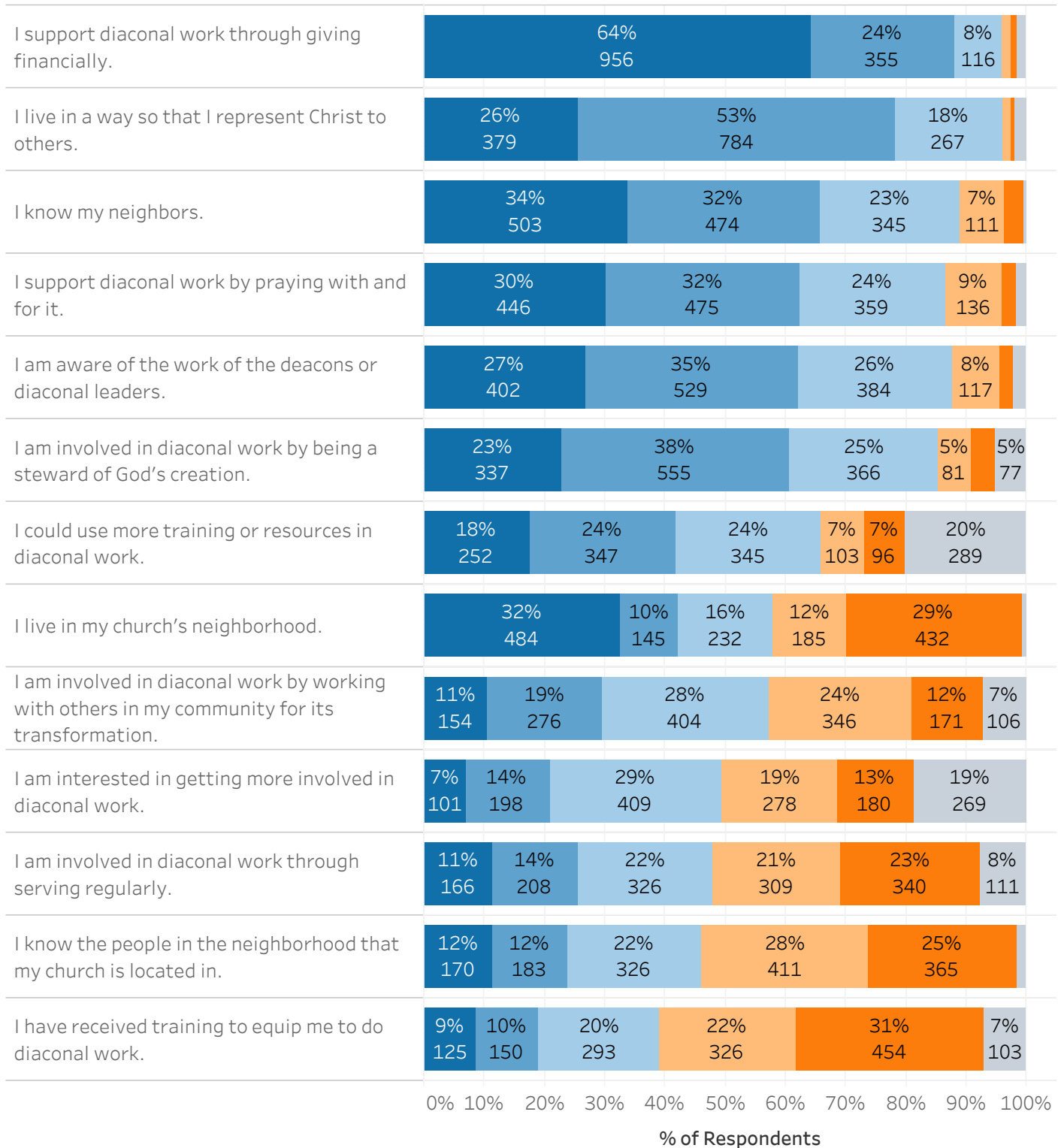

Q39. To me, the term "Christian Reformed" means (check all that apply):



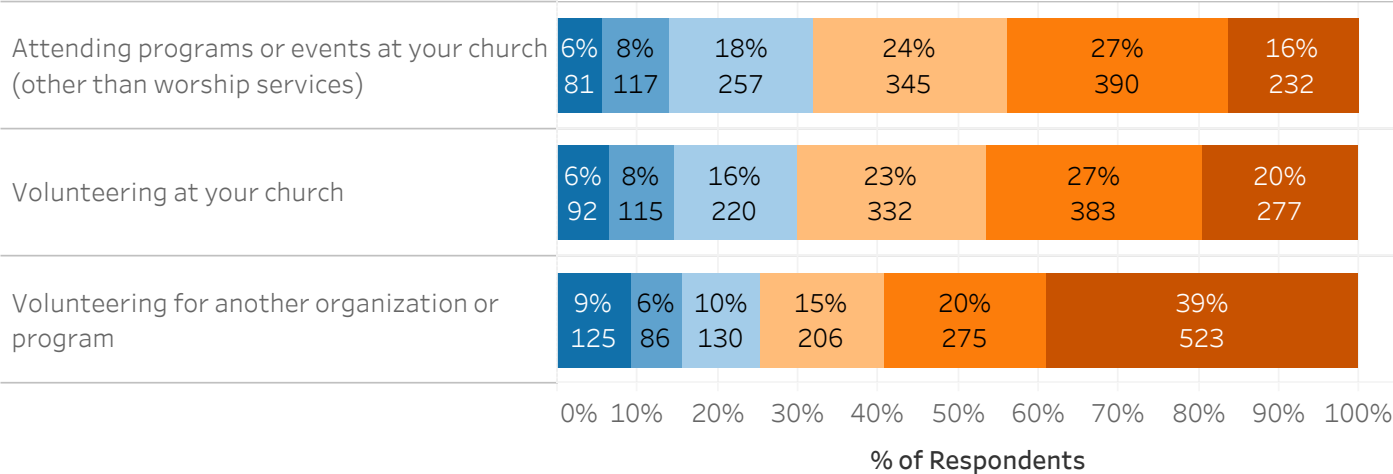

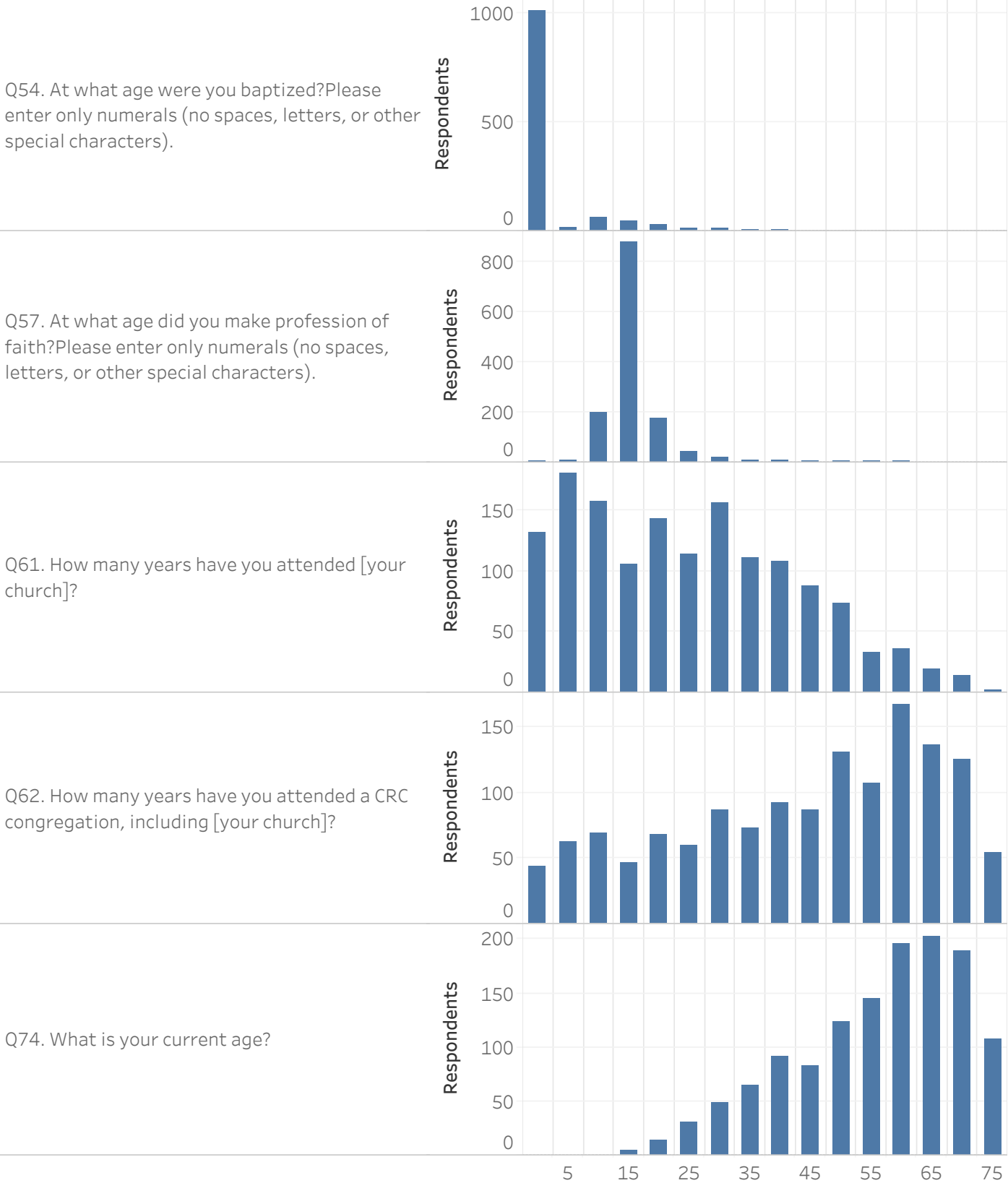

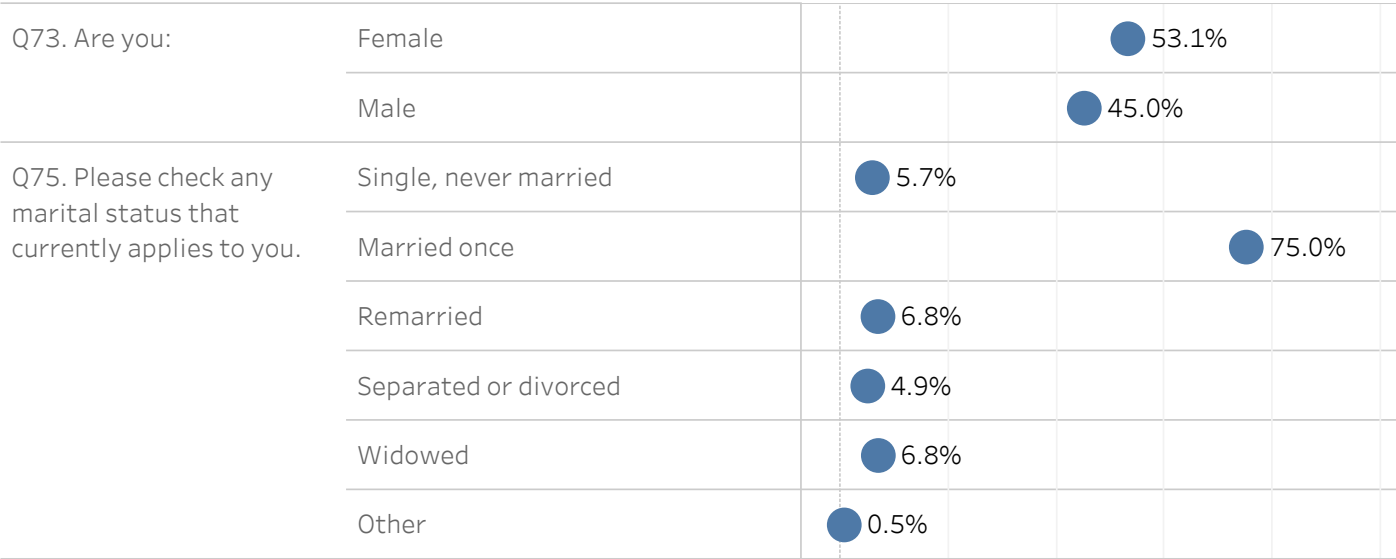
