Demographics: The fourth section contains demographic information for your congregation compared with other participating congregations.




Cultivating Prayer and Spiritual Discipline

Please indicate how true each statement is concerning your church:




Listening to Generational Voices

Please indicate how true each statement is concerning yourself:











Our diaconal work is transforming...




People in our congregation are equipped to...










