Director of Discipleship – Georgetown CRC

The Director of Discipleship is responsible for discipling our children, youth and their families; igniting in them a desire to know, love and follow Jesus. This role will not only create a dynamic discipleship culture across the developmental stages it will equip parents and family discipleship team members to bridge the gap between discipleship at church and at home. This is a part time position of up to 20 hours per week. This position supports Georgetown's ministry priorities of Nurturing full devotion to Christ and Serving in and with our community.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Develop and implement a children's and youth strategy plan in conjunction with church leadership and program volunteer leaders
- 2. Plan, organize, and execute age appropriate serve projects and mission trips. Work with the program volunteers to arrange trip mentors and participants
- 3. Assist with profession of faith preparation and execution
- 4. Lead in evaluating or developing Bible study curriculum for all programs with the assistance of the volunteer program leaders
- 5. Monitor, manage, communicate, encourage, and motivate program volunteers and staff
- 6. Develop and implement a recruitment and training program for teachers and volunteers
- 7. Interact with students
- 8. Provide support to volunteer teachers when requested or a need is determined.
- 9. Manage, as well as develop, an annual ministry budget

Spiritual and Personal Qualifications:

- 1. Demonstrate a growing relationship with Jesus Christ and a mature, Christian lifestyle
- 2. An understanding and belief in the tenets of the Reformed Christian faith
- 3. A commitment to working with the pastors and staff in carrying out the visions and goals of Georgetown church
- 4. Committed to continual spiritual and professional growth
- 5. Relates well to all kinds of people, builds effective relationships, communicates effectively both interpersonally and corporately
- 6. Self-motivated. Able to carry out his/her responsibilities with a minimum of direct supervision
- 7. Proficient in the use of technology

Accountability and Reporting:

- 1. As a member of Georgetown Church staff, the Director of Discipleship is accountable in the day to day performance to his/her responsibilities to the Pastor.
- 2. In the overall performance of ministry, the Director of Discipleship is accountable to Council.
- 3. The work and performance of the Director of Discipleship will be reviewed and evaluated annually by the Elders in consultation with the Pastor.
- 4. The Director of Discipleship will participate in regular meetings with church staff for the purpose of prayer, sharing ideas and plans, support, and encouragement.

Note: As a director of ministry, active membership at Georgetown is expected within one year of employment
