#### Introduction

  to walk in step with the Holy Spirit, to serve each other in harmony, and to engage our local
  community fruitfully.
- Serve as a **mentor** to young ministry leaders as part of our commitment to be a teaching congregation, and encourage others in this ministry of mentorship.

#### **Pastoral Ministry**

- Serve among us with a strong sense of pastoral identity, nurturing and shepherding us as a community
  of care for young and old; new immigrants and longtime local residents; skeptics, seekers, and lifelong
  believers.
- **Equip** elders, deacons, staff, pastoral care assistants, and all members to cultivate a richer culture of care and hospitality in our congregation as we welcome others to join us as a community of disciples.
- Model and promote **healthy approaches** to pastoral ministry by actively relying on the Holy Spirit's guidance and communicating with grace and truth.
