The worship leader coordinates music/songs for the service with the pastor to align with the message and scripture reading. Members often assist during service with reading scripture and announcements, special music, and ministry reports.

We are a supportive, encouraging, and family friendly church that welcomes diversity. We are unified in our love for our church family and desire to reach out to others with the Spirit's strength and leading. We are strong in our belief in the Truth of the Word of God.

We have a passion and desire to be an active and bright light to the community, spreading the gospel of salvation to our neighbors. We have a passion to bless and meet the variety of needs within our present church family, including supporting members and youth in their ministry/mission opportunities. We have a passion for studying the Bible and prayer.

#### List specific problems with which your congregation struggles:

Our church doesn't have a strong presence and is not largely recognized in our community. We are small in numbers, which affects the number of lay leaders, limiting our ability to offer effective ministries and attract new members. We have a heart to grow, but don't know how to effectively do this.

# What has been the most interesting and challenging event in the life of your church in the last three years?

Interesting: A "Picnic in the Park" with our sister Spanish church gave us an opportunity to introduce ourselves to our neighbors.

Challenging: Pastor Eisenring's departure in 2016 due to visionary differences with the Classis and church resulted in members leaving. Difficult challenges and vacancies in the leadership of the church have been a challenge in retaining members.

We want to be obedient to the Great Commission and the Great Commandments, so we can be a positive influence and presence in the City of Chandler. We want to reach out to, and share love to our community, and we are looking for leadership to help us.
