Position Summary

Creation Church seeks a Lead Pastor who is an engaging, inspirational and demonstrated leader.

Primary Responsibilities

- 1. Preaching and Worship
 - Preach the Word: Bring biblical, practical and scripturally based messages to all ages that teach and convict those who are searching as well as challenge and engage the spiritually mature.
 - Plan and lead worship services: Provide direction and coordinate worship services with the worship, music and service team and volunteers.
- 2. Congregation and Community Life
 - Pastoral Care: Visit, counsel, encourage, and pray with church members who have physical, emotional and spiritual needs.
 - Outreach: Model, train and encourage the congregation in participating in God's call to share God's love and gift of salvation with our community. Engage the surrounding community and look for opportunities for our church to be a significant presence and resource within the City of Chandler.
 - Shepherding & Teaching:
 - Youth: Teach, counsel and invest in the education and faith development of our youth. Engage with and look for opportunities to participate in teaching opportunities in area schools.
 - o Adults: Teach, counsel and equip the members of the church to live a life of discipleship to Jesus Christ. Train and equip elders, deacons and other leaders in meeting the ministry needs of our church.
 - Community: Serve as a resource and invite the neighbors in our community to join us for worship and live a life
 of love and service to God.
