GEORGETOWN CHRISTIAN REFORMED CHURCH DIRECTOR OF CHILDREN MINISTIRES POSITION DESCRIPTION

June, 2018

This part-time fifteen hour per week position is responsible for giving direction to the Children's Ministry of Georgetown Church (birth – fifth grade).

This position provide direction for Georgetown's ministry priority: Nurturing full devotion to Christ.

I. Responsibilities:

- A. Provide direction, support, and oversight for the following ministries:
 - 1. Childcare Center
 - 2. Little People's Worship
 - 3. Summer Worship Programs (Sonshine Worship/Toddler Tale)
 - 4. Kingdom Kids
 - 5. Cadets
 - 6. GEMS
- B. Work with the Director of Student Ministries, and the Pastor of Preaching and Discipleship in giving leadership to the Going Public program.
 - C. Recruit volunteer leaders and work closely with them providing leadership, training, counsel, and encouragement.
 - D. Provide Biblical, age appropriate curriculum and other needed resources for teachers and leaders.
 - E. Create inviting, safe space for Children's Ministry programs.
 - F. Regularly evaluate the effectiveness of each program, making necessary adjustments and proposing new programs when existing programs are no longer effective.
 - G. Maintain good communication with volunteers, families in the congregation and the broader church community.
 - H. Develop personal relationships with children of the congregation and their families as well as guests.
 - I. Prepare an Annual Report for the Council.
 - J. Draft and manage the Children's Ministries budget.
 - K. Works collaboratively with staff on various ministry initiatives.
 - L. Meets 10 times per year with Ministry Vision Team (monthly except July and August).

II. Spiritual and Personal Qualifications:

- A. A love for children and a passion for children's ministry.
- B. A growing relationship with Jesus Christ and a mature, Christian lifestyle.
- C. An understanding and belief in the tenets of the Reformed Christian faith.
- D. A commitment to working with the pastors and staff in carrying out the vision and goals of Georgetown Church.

III. Accountability and reporting:

- A. As a member of Georgetown Church staff, the Director of Children's Ministries is accountable in the day to day performance of his/her responsibilities to the Pastor of Preaching and Discipleship.
 - B. In the overall performance of ministry, the Director of Children's Ministries is accountable to the Ministry Vision Team.
 - C. The work and performance of the Director of Children's Ministries will be reviewed and evaluated annually by Pastor of Preaching and Discipleship with assistance from Administrative Support Team.
 - D. The Director of Children's Ministries will participate in regular meetings with the ministry staff for the purpose of prayer, sharing ideas and plans, support, and encouragement.
 - E. Meet quarterly with the Pastor of Preaching and Discipleship and the Deacon of Children's Ministries.
 - F. The Director of Children's Ministries will be given the opportunity to attend the Ministry Leadership Team as necessary.

Note: As a director of ministry, membership at Georgetown is expected within one year of employment.
