## **How We Serve**

LHC has always been a church that believes in reaching out and serving our community. Over the years we have organized and participated in numerous mission trips both near and far.

Locally – we currently have an Events Ministry Team whose purpose is to organize and plan local events that encourage our church to reach out and take part in our community. Over the years our church has participated in many ways.

- Living Hope Food Pantry serves over 500 people per month with 100% volunteers.
- Living in Victory Bible study meets weekly and is open to community.
- Local Mission trips over the years included helping local families individually with projects or a day like Go Sunday when 200 LHC members went out in force to serve our community.
- Harvest Fun Night, Movie Nights, Car Wash for local park, Christmas Parade, Caroling, Hosting Concerts and other creative events all done in the name of Jesus.





Nationally / Globally – We have a Missions Team that organizes, raises funds, and encourages participation in Mission Trips. Most trips involved both youth and adults working together.

- Mission trips occur every few years.
  Recently they have included Haiti (twice), Zuni New Mexico (twice), and an Indian Reservation in Red Lake, MN.
- We also support 4 different
  Missionaries / organizations all with ties to our church.
