Responsibilities:

Worship Ministries:

- Supervise the planning of all worship services in conjunction with staff.
- Preach at all worship services with the exception of 4 vacation weeks and 4 additional Sundays off.
- Work with Worship Ministry Teams to ensure a meaningful worship experience for all, including those who worship online.

Discipleship Ministries:

- Work with designated staff to organize small groups bible studies and prayer groups
- Disciple members of the congregation and community who want to grow in the Lord through one-on-one mentoring.
- With designated staff, lead creation care ministries such as teaching "Creation Station" lessons through the church year.
- Visit with the church's elderly and families in need.
- Support our growth of children's Sunday school ministry.

- Provide guidance and direction to The Refuge's creation care ministries.
