



## What is a residency?

A formational process that lasts a minimum of one year where individuals immerse themselves into the life of a local church in order to intentionally grow in Christ and their vocational calling by working closely with experienced leaders.

## Why a residency?

The purpose is twofold:

- 1) To empower the church in equipping people for ministry.
- 2) To empower individuals to discern their ministry calling as they discover their gifts and grow as Christ followers through hands-on ministry experience.

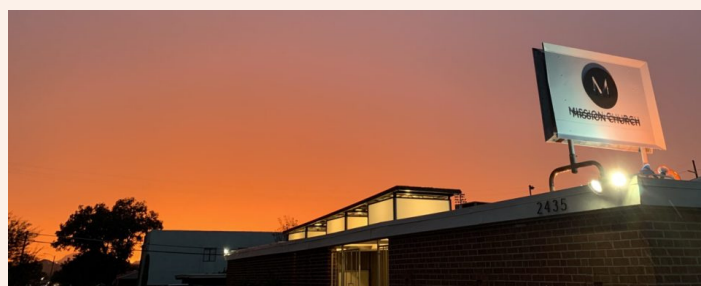
## Who is a residency for?
